
GREEN GIRL CAMPAIGN

This campaign is designed to empower and educate girls about protecting the environment, while also helping them discover their strengths and capabilities. Participants in the program will have the opportunity to acquire a broader range of skills and develop positive attitudes. The program will also focus on promoting gender equality and is open to participants of all genders.

The initiative began by establishing Green Girls Clubs in girls' schools in Sri Lanka and collaborated with UNESCO clubs, along with the Parisara Niyamu School Program in Sri Lankan schools. The initiative was launched in 2014 with the endorsement of the Minister of Youth, Dullas Allahaperuma, and in 2016, it received the support of the Resident Coordinator, Una McCauley.



LEADING THE NATIONAL YOUTH STATEMENT FOR THE UN CLIMATE CHANGE CONFERENCE OF YOUTH (COY) IN 2021



The Road to Rights took the leadership in developing the National Youth Statement for the UN Climate Change Conference of Youth (COY) in 2020 on behalf of all citizens of Sri Lanka. In the writing of this statement, environmental and youth organisations around the country came together to address issues that citizens of Sri Lanka face, emphasizing the need to provide feasible solutions to counter them. At the end, the statement was presented to the Minister of Environment in Sri Lanka.

TREE FOR LIFE - A DIGITAL PLATFORM TO INSPIRE YOUTH TO PLANT TREES



The Road to Rights launched the "TREE FOR LIFE" campaign during the Global Week to ACT4SDGs with the goal of inspiring youth to engage in environmental protection efforts. This initiative centers on a digital platform where young individuals can plant a tree, upload a photo of themselves planting it, and provide information about the tree. Upon submission, participants receive a certificate of recognition that includes the tree-planting picture. This certificate bears the endorsements of the United Nations SDG Action Campaign, The Road to Rights, and the National Youth Services Council. Remarkably, we successfully planted over 700,000 trees during the project.
